



Greetings from Al Wahda Private School in Sharjah.

It is my pleasure that I, Mr. Sean Lewis- Head of Assessment (HOA) is writing to inform you about the EmSAT assessments for all grade 12 students. The EmSAT is a national system of standardized computer-based tests, based on United Arab Emirates national standards. **EmSAT is one of the mandatory requirements for the National Agenda Parameter 2018-2019 and is a mandatory graduation requirement for all grade 12 students.**

The EmSAT assessments measure the knowledge and skills of Grade 12 student's, as they're about to complete their general education and move onto higher education. The assessments provide decision makers with data for college admission and placement.

All Grade 12 students studying in public or private schools must take the EmSAT in English, Math, Science and Arabic.

**All Grade 12 students are required to register for this assessment with the career's counsellor this week within school and students must bring their Emirates ID Card.**

Once registered students will receive their EmSAT username and password by e-mail and will be able to schedule their tests. Students must print a copy of their exam ticket. Please note: the EmSAT assessments are external assessments therefore, the student will be tested at a different location, which will be confirmed during the registration process. It neither necessary nor advised to complete all EmSAT tests on the same day. Students can apply for each test individually at different times and places. Note: that students must register for the English language test first before the registration for the remaining tests

When taking the EmSAT assessments all students are required to be on time and they must their original Emirates ID card along with their exam ticket to gain entry. Once completed the tests students will wait for their results and will receive them on their registered email. The results will be available for viewing and printing in the EmSAT portal.

The terms and conditions of this assessment is also attached and the school will be providing teaching and learning sessions in preparation for the student's assessment.
